

The Whiteside County State's Attorney's office has an immediate opening for an Assistant State's Attorney to work in the area of misdemeanor and traffic prosecution. Pay range will depend on experience with a minimum salary of \$46,789. Advancement is possible.

The State's Attorney's office consists of the State's Attorney, six assistants (one vacancy), a victim's assistant, and a secretarial staff.

Whiteside County is approximately 120 miles west of Chicago and borders the Mississippi river. The county has slightly over 60,000 people and has two court facilities. The county seat is Morrison and the branch court is in Sterling. The county is predominately rural with numerous outdoor and recreational resources.
