

COUNTY OFFICES COMMITTEE: Mr. James Arduini, Chair

The County Offices Committee met on June 30, 2014 at 2:30 PM in Room 108 at the Courthouse. Those present were James Arduini, John Espinoza, Martin Koster, and Ruth Stanley. Also present were Joel Horn, Dana Nelson, Dawn Young, Sue Britt, Jim Britt.

1. Claims were reviewed, Mr. Espinoza moved their approval, Mr. Koster seconded, motion carried.
2. Ms. Nelson reviewed the slate of election judges for 2014-2016. Ms. Stanley moved the slate of election judges be forwarded to the County Board. Mr. Espinoza seconded the motion, motion carried. A copy will be on file at the County Clerk's office for review.

MOTION: To approve the Election Judges for 2014 – 2016, as presented.

3. Ms Nelson reviewed the possible ballot styles for the election this fall. Due to all the state referendums the information will not fit on the normal legal size ballot. She reviewed three possible solutions. The first would be to use two pages. The second would be to use an extra-long custom size ballot, however this may cause excessive jams. The third and most favorable would be to abbreviate the language for the referendums on the ballot and provide the full language in an explanation page that could be passed out and reused. She will keep the committee informed. The State Board of Elections will make the final decision.
4. Ms. Young reviewed the Recorders Semi-Annual report with the committee. Mr. Koster moved the report be placed on file. Mr. Espinoza seconded, motion carried. (See #17)
