OPEN MEETINGS ACT

Probably the most pertinent aspect of the Open Meetings Act is the proper procedure to take the meeting into executive session. To send a meeting into executive session the following must occur:

1. A motion must be made and seconded to take the meeting into executive session.
2. A roll call vote of all members present must be taken and a majority of "yeses" is required to send a meeting into executive session.
3. Once the roll call vote is taken and the votes tabulated and the meeting is still in open session the Chairperson must cite the statutory exception(s) the body is relying on in sending the meeting into executive session and the time the open meeting went into executive session.
4. The Chairperson should say something like "the Board/committee is sending the meeting into executive session based on 5 ILCS 120/2 (c)() (insert particular exception number here)". Translated this means Chapter 5, Act 120, paragraph 2 (c)(), of the Illinois Compiled Statutes.
5. The most commonly used exceptions cited at 5 ILCS 120/2 (c)() are as follows and please note that some numbers are skipped. These exceptions to the Open Meetings Act would not be applicable to the Board or Board Committees:
 1. The appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee to determine its validity.
 2. Collective negotiating matters between the public body and its employees or their representatives, or deliberations concerning salary schedules for one or more classes of employees.
 3. The selection of a person to fill a public office, as defined in this Act, including a vacancy in a public office, when the public body is given power to appoint under law or ordinance, or the discipline, performance or removal of the occupant of a public office, when the public body is given power to remove the occupant under law or ordinance.

5. The purchase or lease of real property for the use of the public body.
6. The setting of a price for sale or lease of property owned by the public body.
7. The sale or purchase of securities, investments, or investment contracts.
8. Emergency security procedures and the use of personnel and equipment to respond to actual danger to the safety of employees, students, staff or public property, provided that a description of the actual danger shall be made a part of the motion to close the meeting.
11. Litigation, when an action against, affecting or on behalf of the particular public body has been filed and is pending before a court or administrative tribunal, or when the public body finds that an action is probable or imminent, in which case the basis for this finding shall be recorded and entered into the minutes of the closed meeting.
12. The establishment of reserves or settlement of claims as provided in the Local Governmental and Governmental Employees Tort Immunity Act, if otherwise the disposition of a claim or potential claim might be prejudiced, or the review or discussion of claims, loss or risk management, information, records, data, advice or communications from or with respect to any insurer of the public body or any intergovernmental risk management association or self insurance pool of which the public body is a member.
14. Informant sources, the hiring or assignment of undercover personnel or equipment, or ongoing, prior or future criminal investigations, when discussed by a public body with criminal investigatory responsibilities.
17. The recruitment, credentialing, discipline or formal peer review of physicians or other health care professional for a hospital, or other institution providing medical care, that is operated by the public body.
21. Discussion of minutes of meetings lawfully closed under this Act, whether for purposes of approval by the body of the minutes or semi-annual review of the minutes as mandated by Section 2.06.

6. To end an executive session there must be a motion and a second. A roll call vote must be taken.
7. No final action may be taken at a closed meeting. Final action shall be preceded by a public recital of the nature of the matter being considered and other information that will inform the public of the business being conducted.

*** PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT WHEN THE PUBLIC BODY ENTERS INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION IT IS LIMITED TO DISCUSS ONLY THOSE TOPICS STATED TO THE PUBLIC PRIOR TO GOING INTO THE EXECUTIVE SESSION.** For example, if the body goes into executive session to discuss litigation, it cannot discuss hiring a new employee. However, the public body may go into executive session based on multiple exceptions to the Open Meetings Act.

Out-of-County Expenses

- Meals and Lodging. Meals and lodging expenses shall be reasonable for the locale in which they were secured and must be documented by a receipt. In no case shall the reimbursement for meals exceed forty one dollars (\$41) In State and fifty dollars (\$50) Out of State per day, without approval from the respective committee.

- Other Travel Expenses. Receipts required. All expenses, even if authorized, must follow the County's Purchasing Policies. The Finance Committee may reject any expenditure which it deems not connected with county business and is further authorized to reject any unreasonable expenditure even though made in connection with county business.

Board Appeals

Allowances and/or reimbursements rejected by the Finance Committee may be appealed to the Executive Committee.
